Dam level decline of 1,1% shows water-wise ways remain important

As expected for this time of the year, which is characterised by the warm and windy weather of summer, the levels of the dams which supply Cape Town have declined by 1,1% over the past week to 71,3 % of storage capacity. This is compared to dam levels of 36,2% at the same time last year.

The average water consumption increased by 18 million litres per day to 576 million litres per day for the past week.

The City encourages water users to continue to be water-wise and to build on the good conservation practices they adopted to beat the drought.
