

New way to report stolen wheelie bins

Police would like to inform all members of the community that the reporting process for a stolen or lost wheelie (municipal) bin has changed. Previously, a member of the public would have had to open a case docket at the local police station for the theft of their wheelie bin, utilising the case number as a reference. The City of Cape Town has now agreed that a sworn affidavit and not a case docket will suffice in requesting the replacement of your wheelie bin. Please ensure that the following is included in your affidavit:

- Municipal account number (usually found on your utility or rates bill)
- The facts/circumstances of the disappearance of the bin (date, time, place where bin was last seen).
